## **Possible Reasons for Participant Transition**

It is the mission of Lichen Oaks Adaptive Riding Center (LOARC) to provide adaptive horsemanship and/or riding lessons to individuals with special needs. Please be advised that transition out of the program may occur for any of the following reasons:

- 1. Participant has reached all of his or her goals and is ready to graduate into a mainstream program.
- 2. Inability of participant to follow directions is interfering with progress toward goals.
- 3. Uncontrolled or inappropriate behavior that constitutes a safety risk to participant, other participants, volunteers and/or staff.
- 4. Any changes in a participant's medical, physical, cognitive or emotional condition or medication(s) that makes adaptive horsemanship and/or riding inappropriate or unsafe.
- 5. Three lessons missed by participant without notification to the Program Director. Remember, if it is necessary to cancel a lesson, please do so at least 24 hours in advance by calling 831-335-2347.
